### English Breakfast

### Earl Grey

### Ceylon

### Peach Green Tea

A traditional green tea blended with real fruit pieces & marigold flowers.

### Peppermint

Classic herbal tea made from the finest peppermint leaves. Entirely caffeine free.

### Lemon & Ginger

### French Roast

### Monsoon Malabar

*Medium roast with a smooth, earthy flavour & sweet spicy kick. Unique to the lush Malabar Coast of southern India where Arabica beans are washed to a pale gold colour by monsoon rains.*

### Old Brown, Java

*Full bodied coffee with rustic, musky, tobacco flavour notes & vanilla aroma. Grown on the old colonial estates on the east end of the Java island in Indonesia. Medium-dark roast.*

### Brazilian

*Brazil Santos medium - dark roast with hints of chocolate, nut & cocoa. Full bodied, low acidity & smooth finish.*

### Ethiopian

*Yirgacheffe Koke. Flavours of chocolate, orange blossom, rose, cherry & apricot. Delicate sweetness & flavour. Medium roast.*

### Kenyan

*Bora Estate, East Africa. A medium-dark roast with hints of blackcurrant, sweet molasses, citrus & caramel.*

### Decaf

*Guatemala Swiss Water Decaf. Medium bodied with fruity, caramel & citrus notes.*
